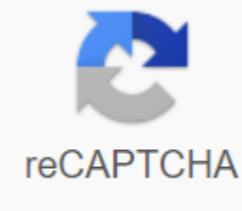

Homework covers all four skills we've seen before. Homework 1 - Write points that belong to each quadrant or axis. Homework 2 - Mark the appropriate box for each couple ordered. Homework 3 - Connect a sequence of dots with linear segments. Homework 4 - Plot the following points in the grid and identify the quadrant in which they are whether. We focus on the description of where the coordinates are. Practice 1 - We have to consider six positions found on the plane coordinates. Practice 2 - Identify the quadrant in which the dot is located (-1, 2). Practice 3 - Use the chart on the right. Note that the dots that do not fall on x or y axis are in one of the four quadrants listed on the right. Practice 4 - Where does it all fall?
